Position involves 65% of time spent in the field and 35% in the office.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Road design and harvest unit layout.
- Harvest, Road Construction/Maintenance, and Silvicultural contract supervision.
- Application of Oregon Forest Practices Act rules and regulations and SFI policy compliance.
- Budget development and tracking / Harvest planning and Scheduling assistance.
- Monitoring and adjusting log quality and manufacturing.
- Creating silvicultural prescriptions including, planting, herbicide application, PCT, etc.
- Preparing maps and other contract documents.
- Ensuring compliance with company and governmental safety standards.
- Working with neighboring landowners on varying agreements.

**Requirements:** Bachelor's degree in Forest Management or a closely related field with a minimum of three years of operational forestry experience and contract administration responsibilities. Five - ten years preferred. Working knowledge of MS Office; GIS programs, silviculture, timberland cruising and an understanding of statistics. Strong analytical and stewardship skills is a must as well as familiarity with the Oregon forest practice rules and notification process. As a team member, the applicant must be self-motivated with a strong work ethic, able to serve in a mentorship capacity, and be an effective member of a highly-motivated team. Strong written and verbal communication skills are essential. The nature of this job requires candidates to be in good physical condition with the ability to walk, climb, and carry/lift 20-40 pounds in rugged terrain. Work is mainly outdoors, often during inclement weather and requires daily local travel with occasional distant travel. Job applicants must possess and maintain a valid driver's license.
